The trainer will advise them when they can exit vehicles, unload ponies and get ready.</li> </ul>	LOW	<ul> <li>Although the groups will be parked separately, and the arriving members will access the training field via a different route to the departing members, they are officially considered as one gathering. It is therefore necessary to ensure that there are never more than six individuals out of their vehicles at one time, in line with government requirements at the time of drawing up this risk assessment.</li> </ul>

			<ul> <li>In a child chest only compressions are unlikely to be successful, hence mouth to month breathing may be required a face shield should be worn if available.</li> <li>HIGH</li> <li>It should be noted that Coronavirus is a mild disease in most people, but a casualty who is not breathing or their heart has stopped is definitely</li> </ul>

Transfer of Covid-19 virus	Tack check, team talk	Trainers PC Members	•	Members must maintain a social distance of 2m at all times Tack checks will not be carried out by the trainer as it is not possible to do so correctly without closing the 2m gap. It is therefore the parent's responsibility to ensure that girths are tightened correctly, stirrups are the correct size, safety peacocks are in good condition and stirrup leather stitching is sound, i.e. there are no broken stitches. Clips should be taped. Rope reins are not allowed and once knotted, the buckle end must be undone, and where this is not possible the loop must be taped.	LOW	<ul> <li>Although the guidance is for 1m +, no- one will be wearing a face mask; a 2m distance is therefore required</li> </ul>
