Position Over a Fence

This is known as the forward seat. It keeps you in the correct jumping position over the horse.



1. Your seat is up out of the saddle.
2. Your weight is in your stirrups.
3. Your body is inclined slightly forward.
4. Your hands are in front of the horse's shoulders.
